

Patient Collection Instructions for Fecal Calprotectin

Specimen	Stool – Preferred first bowel movement of the day.
	Specimen cannot be collected from a diaper.
	Separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.
Labelling	Label container:
	 First and last name
	 Provincial Health Care Number
	 Date and time of collection
	Write date and time of collection on requisition.
Dietary Requirements	• None
Collection Procedure	Collect stool on a dry clean surface:
	 Place sheet of plastic wrap or newspaper over toilet if a receptacle is not provided
	 Do not mix stool with urine or water
	 Transfer a walnut size amount of stool into a container with a disposable utensil if a stick is not provided
	 Screw lid tightly onto container
Required Volume	Optimal Volume: Walnut size amount
Stability/ Storage	• Store at refrigeration temperature (2-8°C) or on an ice pack until delivered to the laboratory.
	• Can be dropped off at RUH Test Centre, SPH Test Centre or any LifeLabs Medical Laboratories.
